



CHILD SAFEGUARDING 2025-2026 Academic Year

Guidance for adults visiting, volunteering, or working at Lizzie Rose Dance Teaching

Adults working with young children and young adults must be made aware of the risks of abuse. This can include abuse by another child/young individual or an adult.

Lizzie Rose Dance Teaching believes that all students in our care have the right to be safe from harm, abuse, and exploitation. This includes everyone regardless of their religion, ethnicity, age, gender, race, sexuality, or disability.

If anyone working for, volunteering or visiting Lizzie Rose Dance Teaching has concerns about a student's welfare, please report to Lizzie and/or the relevant organisations and/or authorities immediately.

- You could write notes about your concerns
- Report to a charity or organisation that specialises in child safety
- Report to any member of staff
- Report to the police or local authorities and/or council

If you are suspicious of any form of abuse of a student or you are concerned about a member of staff/volunteer/visitor, it is your duty to report this concern.
